Land Acknowledgement

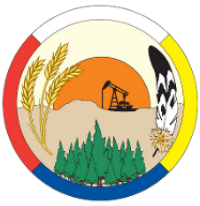

INTENT: Information

Background:

The Facilities Department continues to provide effective and responsive support across the division, with a focus on building internal capacity and improving service delivery. Recent efforts have centered on enhancing staff knowledge and strengthening collaboration across departments.

Over the past several months, the Facilities team has significantly expanded its working knowledge of fire and security systems. This growing expertise has resulted in faster response times to system issues and a reduced reliance on external contractors, improving both efficiency and cost control.

Professional development remains an important priority. Attendance at the recent SASBO Conference provided valuable insights and reinforced the benefit of collaboration with other school division facilities departments. These opportunities continue to support the sharing of best practices and innovative approaches within the sector.

Current Status:

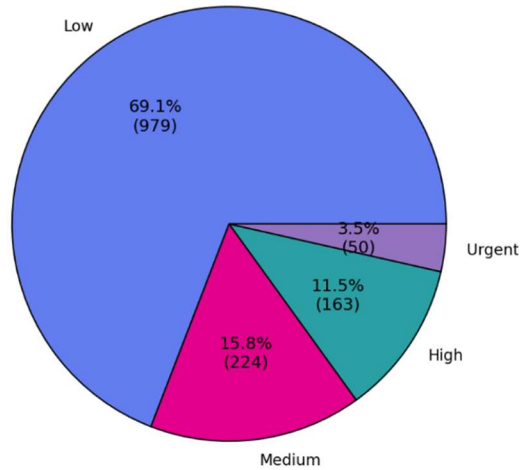
The Facilities team has focused on seasonal work as well as many repairs throughout the division and remained highly productive in addressing service requests. Data from the past 4 - 5 months:

- Service requests completed: 1,350
- Service requests received: 1,417
- Current open service requests assigned to the 8 trades: 209



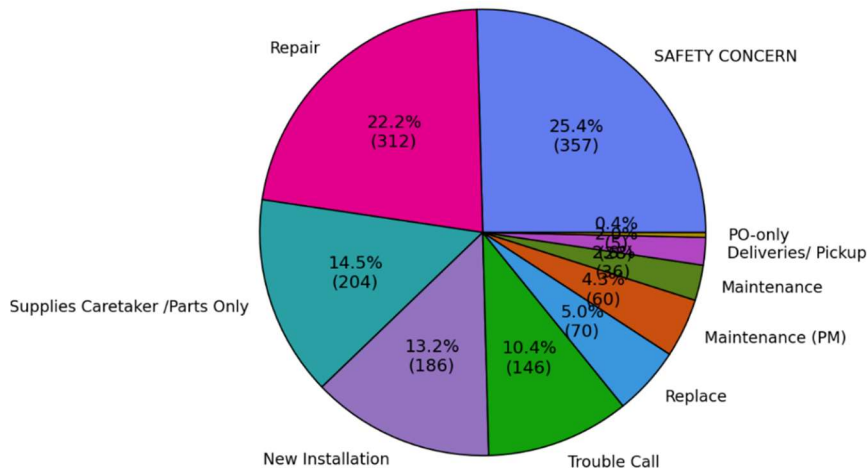
A breakdown of service requests received by category is provided below.

The majority of our “safety concern” service requests will be snow removal. All our caretakers log their snow removal with pictures via a service request.



Photos of completed and ongoing projects across the division have been attached.

- In collaboration with the IT Department, Facilities has implemented a fully in-house managed door access system. This approach has proven to be more cost-effective than contracted services while ensuring complete internal oversight and understanding of the system from installation through to ongoing management and support.





Capital Project Updates that are in progress:

Medstead School Renovation

- Project is **86% complete**
- Anticipated completion date: **August 1, 2026**

Norman Carter Elementary School

- Roof replacement progressing as expected
- Anticipated completion date: **July 30, 2026**

St. Vital School

- Roofing replacement almost completed, just awaiting the fall protection equipment installation
- Anticipated completed date: **June 1, 2026**

Unity Public School

- Roofing replacement approximately **95% complete**
- Awaiting installation of fall-protection equipment in spring

Macklin Central School: Water Diversion Project Tender

Facilities is providing notification to the Board regarding the Macklin Central School water diversion project. This project is intended to address ongoing water intrusion and localized flooding issues at the rear of the school site through the implementation of a targeted drainage and water management system.

The scope of work includes the installation of window wells and drainage pits, as well as a drainage line that will connect to the municipal groundwater system to ensure proper water diversion and discharge away from the building.

The project was publicly tendered, and two compliant bids were received. A value-based selection process was used to evaluate submissions, incorporating bid price, contractor experience, and proposed schedule.

The evaluation results are summarized as follows:

- **ConTech:** \$359,999.00 – Total Score: 86.6 / 100
- **Unicon:** \$394,000.00 – Total Score: 82.8 / 100






Based on the outcome of the evaluation, **ConTech** achieved the highest overall score and has been selected as the successful proponent.

The project is scheduled to commence during the summer construction period.

Spiritwood High School

- Approval has been received from the Ministry for a new **Minor Capital Project** at Spiritwood High School, with funding of **\$4.5 million** allocated for roofing and building envelope upgrades. Given recent increases in inflation and fuel costs, there is some concern that the approved budget may not fully cover project expenses. An RFP has been issued to engage a consultant to support project planning and implementation, and the project will be tendered once the design drawings are complete. To maximize flexibility in managing the available funding, the tender will include optional components, allowing the Division to prioritize and adjust the scope of work to achieve the best overall value within the approved budget.

INTENT: Human Resources Update

Human Resources Update: 2025–2026

1. Staffing Stability & Workforce Planning

Human Resources has focused on supporting staffing stability across the division while preparing for future workforce needs. Key areas of focus this year have included:

- Teacher and administrator recruitment and staffing for the 2025–2026 and 2026–2027 school years.
- Leadership succession planning and administrator appointments.
- Development and refinement of optimal staffing processes, including kindergarten, Student Support Teacher (SST), and administrative staffing considerations to support equitable and responsive allocation of resources.
- Initial development of long-range enrolment projections to support future planning and decision-making.

Staffing Highlights

- See the Confidential HR Board Report for staffing details.

Human Resources continued to prioritize proactive recruitment and staffing efforts to support stable learning environments and continuity for students.

2. Supporting Principals Through Human Resources Leadership

A significant focus this year has been supporting school administrators in navigating increasingly complex human resource matters. This has included:

- Coaching and support related to attendance concerns and employee wellness,
- Guidance in performance support and supervision processes,





- Assistance with workplace concerns, and
- Ongoing consultation related to employee relations and procedural fairness.

3. Attendance, Wellness, and Continuity of Learning

Human Resources has worked alongside schools to balance employee wellness with continuity of learning for students. Areas of focus have included:

- Improved tracking and monitoring of employee absences,
- Support for attendance and wellness conversations at the school level,
- Return-to-work planning and employee support, and
- Preparation for and implementation of updated leave management processes.

4. Building Consistency in HR Systems and Processes

This year included significant work to strengthen consistency, transparency, and efficiency in Human Resources practices across the division. Work has included:

- Development of standardized templates and communication processes,
- Clarification and refinement of leave processes and procedures,
- Ongoing review and updating of Human Resources administrative procedures,
- Enhanced onboarding and support for new employees and administrators,
- HR continued to advance the implementation of Atrieve, the organization's new HRIS platform, with a focus on strengthening core HR and payroll processes. Despite tight implementation timelines, the HR and Payroll modules were successfully brought live, marking a significant milestone in the transition to a more integrated and efficient system, and
- Planning is now underway for the next phase of implementation, which includes the Absence Management module targeted for launch in the fall. Work over the summer months will focus on configuration, testing, change management, and employee training to support a smooth rollout and ensure employees and leaders are prepared to use the system effectively.

5. Recruitment, Beginning Teacher Mentorship, and Future Talent Development

Recruitment and retention remain key priorities, particularly in rural education contexts. Efforts this year have included:





- Increased participation in education career fairs to strengthen recruitment efforts and build awareness of opportunities within Living Sky School Division,
- Hosting and strengthening division engagement opportunities with interns through the annual intern event,
- Supporting recruitment for teaching and leadership positions,
- Supporting pathways into the profession, including temporary teaching permit processes,
- Development of a Beginning Teacher Mentorship initiative to support new teachers, with implementation planned for Fall 2026, and
- Continued consideration of strategies to support future leadership and workforce needs.

6. Labour Relations and Collaborative Practice

Human Resources has continued to support positive labour relations and collaborative problem-solving throughout the division. Areas of focus have included:

- Ongoing collaboration with employee groups and union partners,
- Preparation for and participation in LINC negotiations processes,
- Continued focus on fair, transparent, and student-centered employment practices,
- HR successfully concluded CUPE bargaining negotiations, resulting in the ratification of a four-year collective agreement. This outcome provides stability and clarity for both the organization and unionized employees over the agreement term, and
- HR also supported the successful acquisition and transition of the transportation department through the successorship process with CUPE 4747, effective June 1, 2026. This work helped ensure continuity of operations, alignment of employment terms, and a structured transition for affected employees and stakeholders.

SUBJECT: Approval of 3-Year Preventative Maintenance and Renewal (PMR) Plan

ORIGINATOR: Facilities Specialist- Wilma Peek

BACKGROUND:

The Preventative Maintenance and Renewal (PMR) program supports ongoing investment in school facilities to ensure buildings remain safe, functional, and compliant with current standards. This work includes replacements, system upgrades, and renewal projects required to extend the life of division assets.

Facilities have developed a three-year PMR plan that identifies priority projects across all division facilities. The plan reflects current assessments of building condition, lifecycle requirements, and operational needs.

The proposed PMR plan is comprehensive in scope, incorporating all projects identified by facilities as necessary to maintain building operations and avoid accelerated deterioration over the coming years.

It is important to note that, once approved, the Ministry provides flexibility to adjust the timing of projects within the three-year window. This allows facilities to respond to shifting priorities, emerging issues, and changing urgency while remaining within the approved plan.

The PMR plan:

- Covers the 2027–2028, 2028–2029, and 2029–2030 school years.
- Includes projects across all major building systems (mechanical, electrical, structural, exterior and interior).
- Prioritizes work required to maintain safe, efficient, and operational learning environments.
- Supports long-term asset management and sustainability.

1. Mosaic Challenge Recipients

On behalf of the Saskatchewan School Boards Association and The Mosaic Company, I want to acknowledge and congratulate your school division's participation in the 2026 Mosaic School Nutrition Challenge. The commitment to improve student nutrition and health by creating a healthier learning environment is truly admirable.

2. Smile Cookie Campaign

Just before the board meeting, we are being presented with a cheque for taking part in the Smile Cookie campaign, so be sure to ask us about it! This money goes to LSKYSD's Innovation Fund in support of the *Everyone Can Play* initiative.

3. Agreements

Doug will provide a quick update regarding the signing of the Poundmaker transportation contract, government approval of the MGBHLM urban reserve in North Battleford, and government approval of the Pelican Lake urban reserve in Leoville.

4. Provincial Education Plan – Update

Below are updates on each of the four provincial priorities.

Priority Action: Learning and Assessment

Saskatchewan Student Assessment

As of February 20, 2026, 324 teachers representing all 27 school divisions and the Saskatchewan Distance Learning Centre have been directly involved in Saskatchewan Student Assessments. Additional opportunities for teachers to participate in question development and scoring will be available next school year.

This spring, all students in Math 5, ELA 7 and Math 9 will take part in an online field test during May and June. The Ministry of Education will invite stakeholders to provide feedback on which assessment data is most valuable and useful to them.

Actions to Improve Early Literacy

The K–3 reading scope and sequence is currently being piloted, and work is underway on a draft K–3 written and oral language scope and sequence.

The ministry has partnered with Saskatchewan Teachers’ Federation Professional Learning to provide early literacy professional development opportunities. It has also acquired a suite of Provincial Reading Screeners in both French and English. Developed by literacy experts and aligned with the Saskatchewan scope and sequence, these tools will help teachers identify students who require additional reading supports. Support videos have also been created to assist teachers with administering the screeners.

There is no required reading data submission to the ministry for the 2025–26 school year. Future reporting will instead focus on “Students Requiring Additional Supports” and “Students Not Requiring Additional Supports.”

Priority Action: Mental Health and Well-being

A bank of verified, culturally responsive and trauma-informed mental health and well-being resources has recently been updated with additional materials. These resources are available through the PEP and Nurturing Resilience portals.

The Mental Health and Well-being (MHWB) team continues to collaborate with the Ministry of Health, the Saskatchewan Advocate for Children and Youth, the Center for Trauma Informed Practices and Mental Health Capacity Building (MHCB) to support the mental health and wellness of Saskatchewan students.

Members of the MHWB team are also piloting a staff perceptual survey pool connected to MHCB.

Priority Action: Indigenous Education

Work is underway on a sector-wide terminology guide designed to support a shared understanding of language aligned with the five policy goals of Inspiring Success. The guide will draw on guidance from Elders and Knowledge Keepers, as well as existing educational, policy and legislative sources. An initial list of terms was shared at the February PEPIT meeting.



A representative workforce strategy is also being developed to support a more inclusive education sector. The strategy will help guide efforts to attract, support and retain a diverse range of educators and staff.

Under Milestone 3, an Indigenous Education Resources overview has been added to the Saskatchewan Curriculum website. This resource supports educators and students in locating First Nations and Métis curriculum-related materials.

New and refined measures under the Inspiring Success priority will focus on strengthening land-based learning, Indigenous language education and workforce representation.

Priority Action: Student Transitions

The Share Framework: Family Engagement in Saskatchewan has been developed in both English and French. The framework establishes shared language and a common understanding of family engagement across Saskatchewan while allowing school divisions the flexibility to strengthen engagement in ways that best meet local needs.

The next phase of this work involves developing a playbook that will provide practical, research-based strategies to support family engagement. The playbook will include a variety of implementation approaches.

All 27 school divisions collaborated with early learning partners to identify programs and supports available to help children transition into school. This work has improved coordination among schools, families and community services.

The AI-enabled classroom technology field test currently involves 17 schools across nine school divisions. The tool supports middle years student engagement by helping teachers better understand student learning in real time.

Work is also underway to enhance graduation and life pathway planning based on feedback from educators, parents and students. Supported by the Saskatchewan Educational Leadership Unit at the University of Saskatchewan, this work will help inform future programming.

5. The Sky’s the Limit!

Advanced Placement (AP) courses provide students with opportunities to enrich and challenge their learning by studying university-level material while still in high school. Beginning next year, SkyPlus will offer AP Calculus.
